

¹ Those conflicts and disputes among you, where do they come from? Do they not come from your cravings that are at war within you? ²You want something and do not have it; so you commit murder. And you covet something and cannot obtain it; so you engage in disputes and conflicts. You do not have, because you do not ask. ³You ask and do not receive, because you ask wrongly, in order to spend what you get on your pleasures. ⁴Adulterers! For the 2017 financial year, we have a very small deficit of \$157 in our operating budget. July contributions reduced the deficit to basically zero and we are on budget at the half way point of 2017.
