World Communion Sunday

Job 2:7-13

⁷ So Satan went out from the presence of the Lord, and inflicted loathsome sores on Job from the sole of his foot to the crown of his head. ⁸ Job took a potsherd with which to scrape himself, and sat among the ashes.

⁹ Then his wife said to him, 'Do you still persist in your integrity? Curse God, and die.' ¹⁰ But he said to her, 'You speak as any foolish woman would speak. Shall we receive the good at the hand of God, and not receive the bad?' In all this Job did not sin with his lips.

¹¹ Now when Job's three friends heard of all these troubles that had come upon him, each of them set out from his home—Eliphaz the Temanite, Bildad the Shuhite, and Zophar the Naamathite. They met together to go and console and comfort him. ¹² When they saw him from a distance, they did not recognize him, and they raised their voices and wept aloud; they tore their robes and threw dust in the air upon their heads. ¹³ They sat with him on the ground for seven days and seven nights, and no one spoke a word to him, for they saw that his suffering was very great.


Then Eliphaz the Temanite answered:

² 'If one ventures a word with you, will you be offended? But who can keep from speaking? ³ See, you have instructed many; you have strengthened the weak hands.

⁴ Your words have supported those who were stumbling, and you have made firm the feeble knees. ⁵ But now it has come to you, and you are impatient; it touches you, and you are dismayed. ⁶ Is not your fear of God your confidence, and the integrity of your ways your hope?

⁷ 'Think now, who that was innocent ever perished? Or where were the upright cut off? ⁸ As I have seen, those who plough iniquity and sow trouble reap the same. ⁹ By the breath of God they perish, and by the blast of his anger they are consumed.

¹⁷ 'Can mortals be righteous before God? Can human beings be pure before their Maker? ¹⁸ Even in his servants he puts no trust, and his angels he charges with error; ¹⁹ how much more those who live in houses of clay, whose foundation is in the dust, who are crushed like a moth.

The **Mostly Liturgical Worship Service** at **9:00 am** uses liturgy, hymns, worship songs, and silence to guide us in the worship of God. The **10:35 am Church From Scratch Worship Service** blends all different types of music, arts, liturgy and free-form worship to help guide newcomers and experienced alike in the worship of God. **During the Summer** and on **Family Worship Sunday**, selected Sundays throughout the year, we come together as one worshipping family at **9:30 am**.

A **Nursery**, (downstairs) is available for children two and under at both worship hours. A **"Family Room"** on the right side of the Sanctuary is available, as well.

Teaching these skills has significantly reduced the rate of women returning to prison. Vie Thorgren, the Executive Director at the Center for Spirituality at Work, will be joined by Making Choices graduates to share with us. Everyone is invited to learn more about the ministry and also about the reforms that are needed in our prison system that we as Christians might care about.

On **Monday evening, November 19** (time TBD, but probably around 6 pm), join Pastor John and Memory Lamfers on a field trip to the Denver Women's Correctional Facility to participate in a **Making Choices graduation ceremony**. This is an opportunity to hear testimonies and support women who've completed the Booster program about positive decision-making. There's no substitute for hearing first hand how life-changing this program is. We'll carpool from Trinity. **Visitors need to be pre-screened by the Dept. of Corrections**, so please let Pastor John know by **October 22**, if you'd like to come.


