The **10:35 am Church From Scratch Worship Service** blends all different types of music, arts, liturgy and free-form worship to help guide newcomers and experienced alike in the worship of God. **During the Summer** and on **Family Worship Sunday**, selected Sundays throughout the year, we come together as one worshiping family at **9:30 am**.

A **Nursery**, (downstairs) is available for children two and under at both worship hours. A "**Family Room**" on the right side of the Sanctuary is available, as well.
